The calendar year comes to a close after competition of a bonanza of sporting events along with inter- school competitive events.

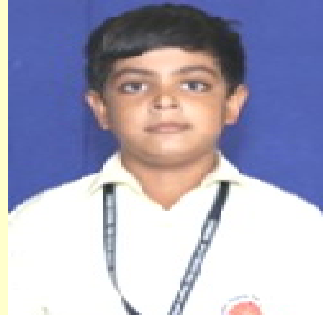

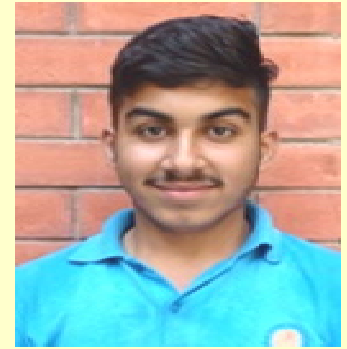

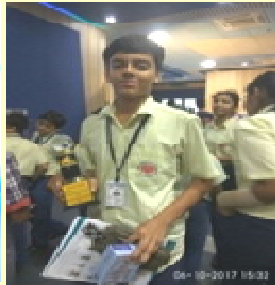

Chitrax bags junior boys title

Ahmedabad: Top seed Chitrax Bhatt defeated third seed Pratham Madhani of Baroda 4-3 in the Sub-Junior Boys' Final of the State & Inter District Table Tennis Championships 2017 in Gandhidham on Wednesday. This was sixth state tournament title for Chitrax this season, which also meant the lanky Amdavadi will keep the state championship trophy with him for second consecutive season.

Having won all the five state ranking titles in 2017, Chitrax started as favourite in the Wednesday's final. However, he faced a stiff competition as Baroda paddler Pratham used both sides of the table with perfection. Pratham showed lot of grit with some swift movements across the table and down the line shots taking the match into the decider. However, Chitrax held his nerve and raised his game to win 7-11 13-11 11-6 11-4 5-11 12-14 11-7.

Amdavadis dominated cadet section with boys and girls' titles. Anuj Joshi defeated Maanas Kataria in the all-Ahmedabad final, while Janya Parikh got the better of Bhavnagar's Khushi Jadav to win girls' crown.

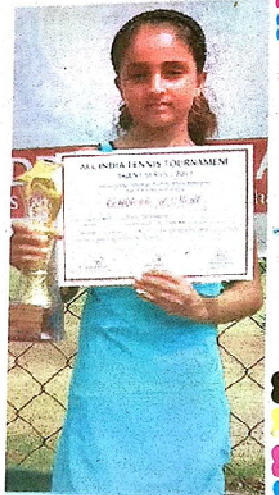

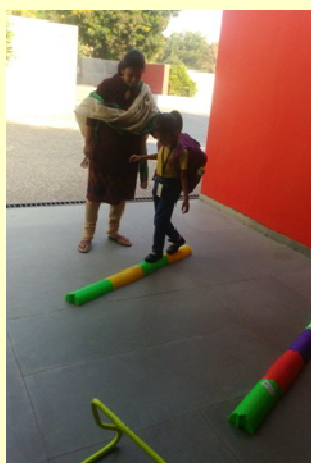
